



## Build the Bike Route System

### Project Highlights

- This project is funded annually at \$750,000 through 2040, with a total funded amount of \$15 million.
- Consistent with updates provided to the IA Board, Blueprint will implement projects under this program according to the below process:
  - Leveraging opportunities with Blueprint, City, County, and private road projects that have bicycle facility improvements identified.
  - Tier 1 Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Projects
  - Projects identified as part of the Facilities Gap Analysis completed by the Tallahassee-Leon County Planning Department.

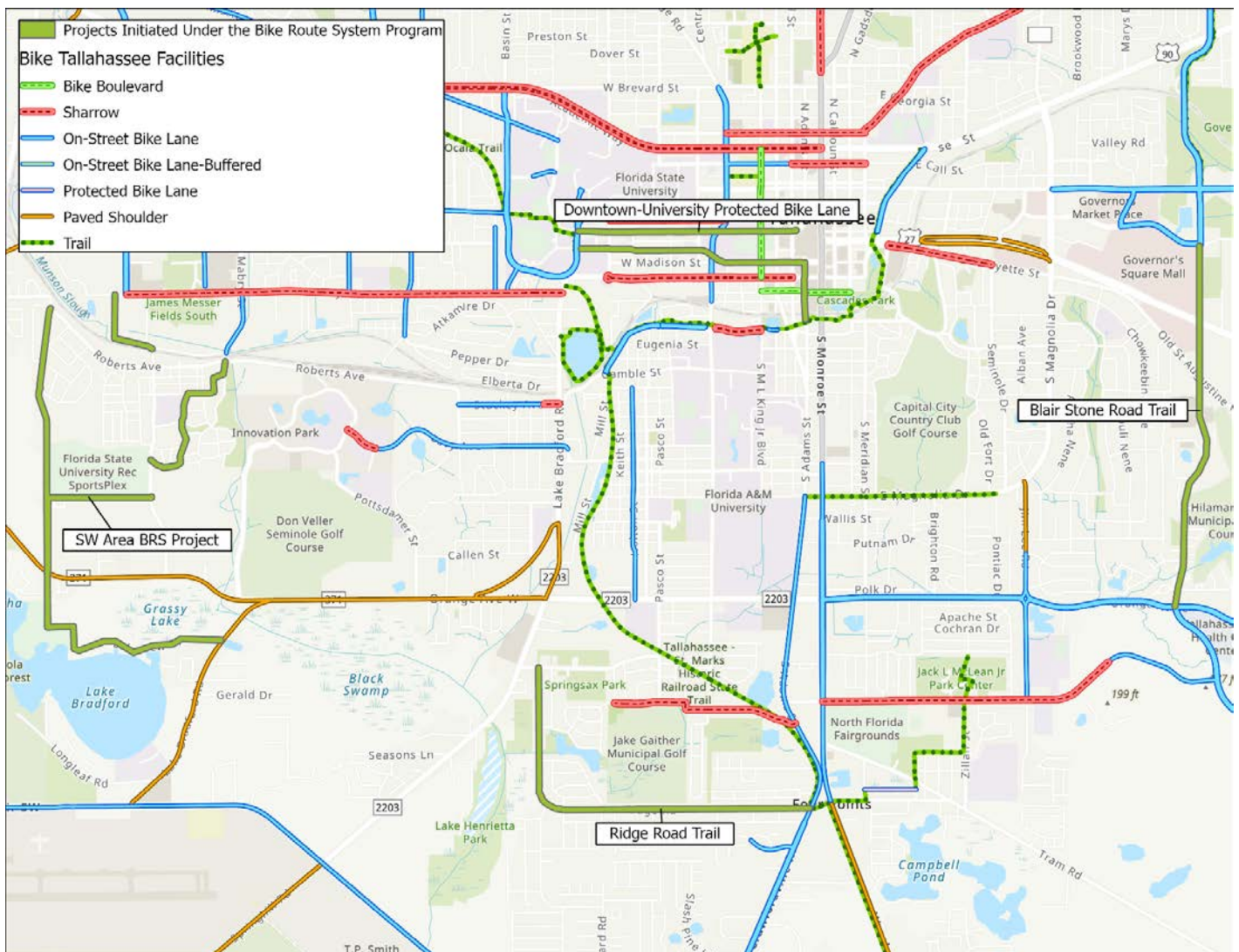
### Current Status

- The IA Board authorized procurement of design and construction services for the Downtown-University Protected Bike Lane project at its February 18, 2021 meeting. Procurement is being finalized for design services.
- The IA Board approved the Proposed FY 2022 BRS Work Program at their May 2021 workshop, and ratified those actions on July 15, 2021. The work program includes feasibility studies for three projects:
  - Ridge Road Trail
  - Blair Stone Road Trail
  - SW Area – which will include connections between the Tallahassee Museum, Debbie Lightsey Nature Park, the FSU RecPlex, the University Greenway, and surrounding neighborhoods

## Next Steps

- Design for the Downtown-University Protected Bike Lane is anticipated to be completed in early 2022.
- The FY 2022 BRS Work Program will be finalized upon adoption of the FY 2022 Blueprint Budget by the IA Board at their September 27, 2021 meeting.
- Blueprint will procure planning services for the three feasibility studies utilizing its continuing services agreements in late 2021/early 2022.
