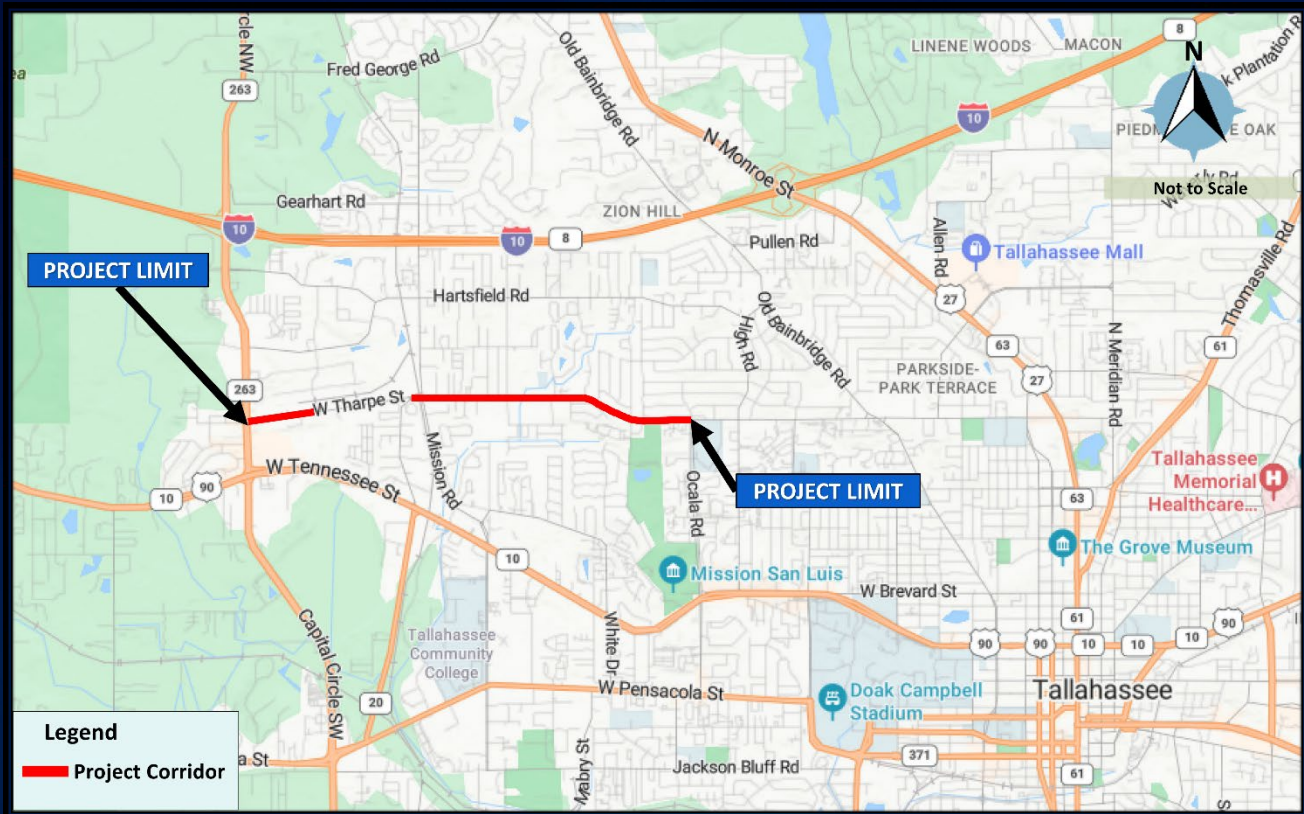

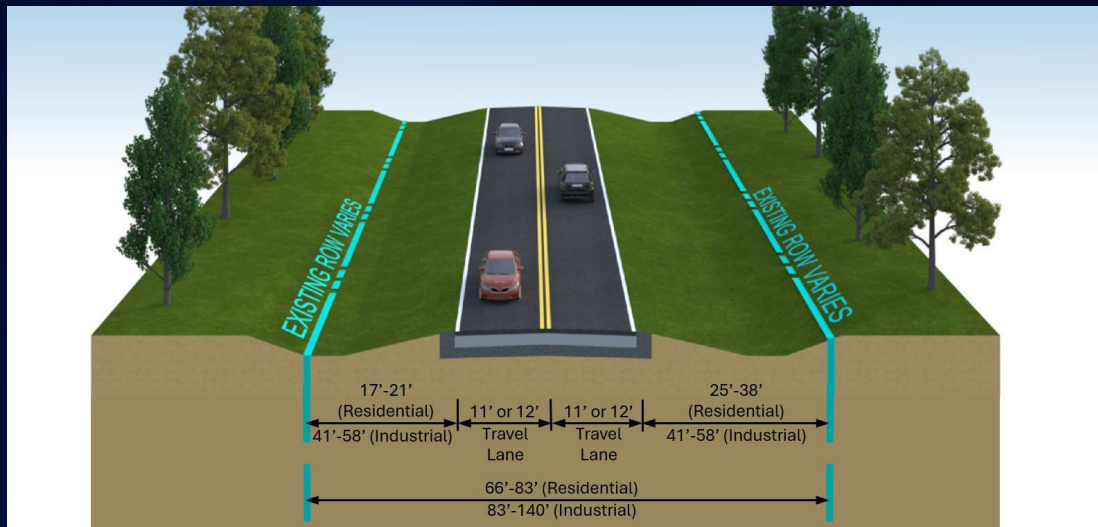

What is a PD&E Study

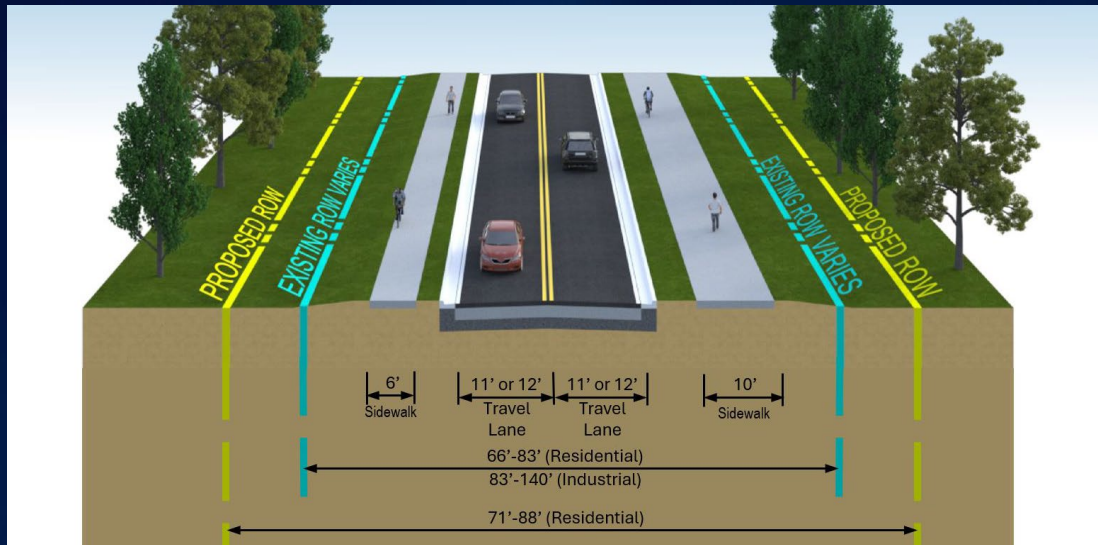
A PD&E Study is the formal process that develops and compares alternatives to determine a preferred action that meets project goals, while minimizing impacts to the social, natural, cultural, and physical environments. Engaging the public by sharing and receiving information is a key component of this process and is required by the National Environmental Policy Act.



Alternatives Under Consideration



No-Build Alternative – One lane in each direction. From CCNW to Mission Rd, travel lanes are 12-foot wide. From Mission Rd to Ocala Rd, travel lanes are 10-foot to 12' wide.



Build Alternative – One lane in each direction with curb and gutter on the outside. A six-foot sidewalk on the north side and a ten-foot sidewalk/shared use path on the south side. From CCNW to Mission Rd, travel lanes will be 12-foot wide. From Mission Rd to Ocala Rd, travel lanes will be 10 to 12-foot wide.
