



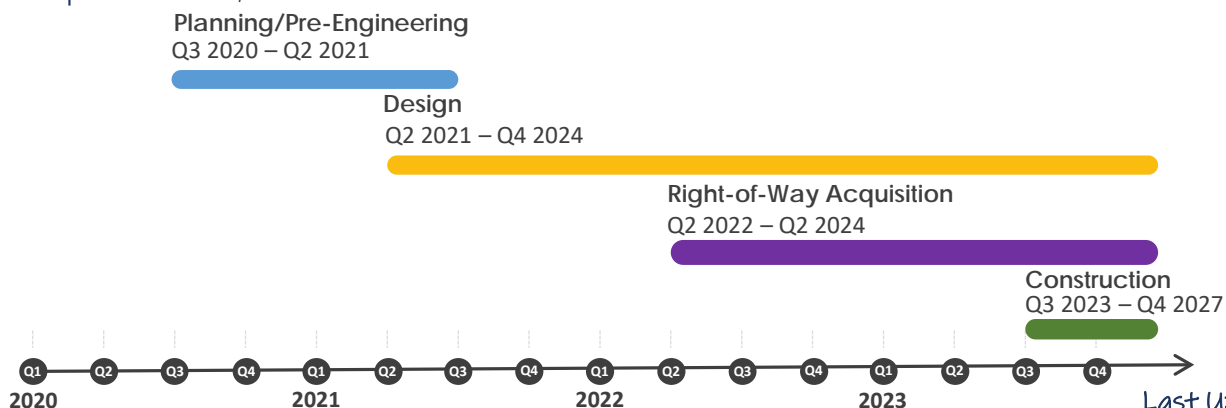
Airport Gateway

Project Highlights

- The purpose of the Project is to create a unique gateway entrance into Downtown, FSU, and FAMU from the Tallahassee International Airport.
- The Project includes planned improvements for over 7 miles of southwest area roadways, a new road within FSU’s southwest campus, and includes approximately 12 miles of new sidewalks, bicycle lanes, and multiuse trails.

Current Status:

- The Southwest Area Transportation Plan, which provides planning and analysis of existing traffic data for road segments included in this project, was completed in 2019.
- Blueprint is coordinating with the Florida Department of Transportation regarding its current PD&E Study of Orange Avenue from Monroe Street to Capital Circle Southwest.
- Planning for the Airport Gateway is estimated to begin in Fall 2020.
- The design of roadway improvements for Springhill Road, Stuckey Avenue, and a new road within FSU’s southwest campus, as well as Levy Avenue and neighborhood improvements, are scheduled for Phase 1.
