



Build the Bike Route System

Project Highlights

- This project is funded annually at \$750,000 through 2040, with a total funded amount of \$15 million.
- Projects under this program will be implemented according to the below process:
 - Leveraging opportunities with Blueprint, City, County, and private road projects that have bicycle facility improvements identified.
 - Tier 1 Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Projects.
 - Projects identified as part of the Facilities Gap Analysis completed by the Tallahassee-Leon County Planning Department.

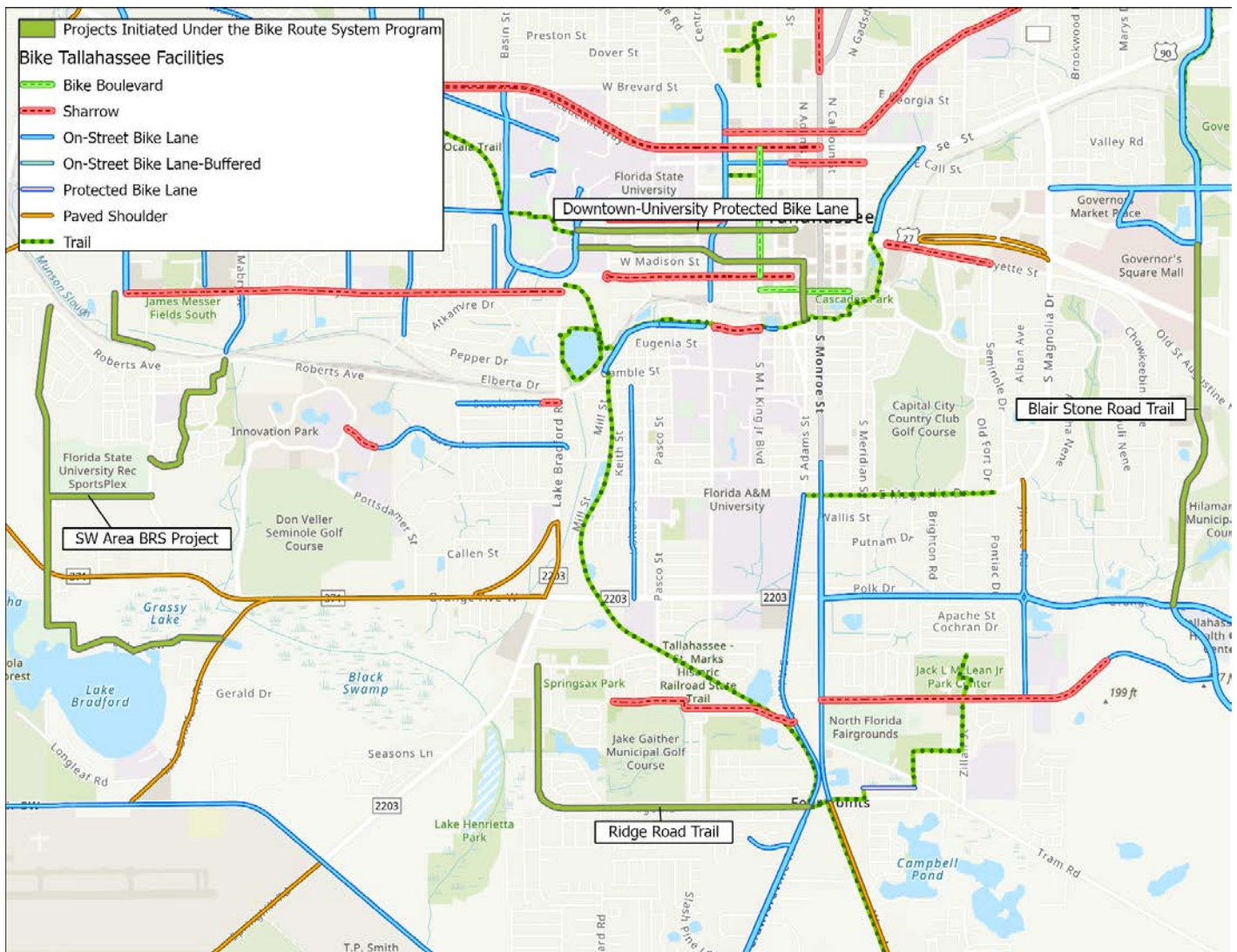
Current Status

- The proposed FY 2022 Bike Route System Work Program [[linked here](#)] was finalized with the IA Board adoption of the FY 2022 Capital Budget.
- The Downtown-University Protected Bike Lane is in design. Design and construction for this project was approved at the February 18, 2021 IA Board meeting.
- Three feasibility studies, approved by the IA Board for the FY 2022 Work Program, are currently in scope development and fee negotiations. The studies will evaluate the feasibility for bicycle facilities along:
 - Blair Stone Road (from Orange Ave to Gov. Sq. Blvd.)
 - Ridge Road
 - SW Area of Tallahassee-Leon County (connecting Tallahassee Museum, Debbie Lightsey Nature Park, FSU Rec SportsPlex, and the University Greenway)

Next Steps

- Design for the Downtown-University Protected Bike Lane is anticipated to be completed in early 2022.
- An update on these projects and a proposed FY 2023 Bike Route System Work Program will be presented at the May 2022 Budget Workshop.
