



Midtown Placemaking

Project Highlights

- The Midtown Placemaking project provides funding to implement the infrastructure improvements recommended by the Midtown Placemaking Action Plan and the Capital Region Transportation Agency (CRTPA) Midtown Area Transportation Plan.
- In 2020, CRTPA developed the Midtown Area Transportation Plan, which included public input on priorities and recommended concepts for streetscaping, safety, and resiliency improvements.
- The Midtown Placemaking corridors are state roadways, listed below, managed by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

Current Status

- On March 4, 2025, a community meeting was held by FDOT. Based on feedback from the community, FDOT is not moving forward with the placemaking improvements on Thomasville from Monroe Street to 7th Avenue.

Next Steps

- Blueprint will continue to pursue leveraging opportunities with FDOT for completion of all project phases on state roadways.
- Design for FDOT resurfacing project along Thomasville Rd. from Monroe Street to 9th Avenue is currently underway, with implementation anticipated in late 2026. Additional information can be found on the [FDOT website](#).
